She tells of an adopted woman searching for biological relatives and of sisters trying to solve a family mystery. Hess' interest in plants, sea treasures, and antiques evidences itself in several other stories. This is the author's first book of fiction. Hess enjoys writing dialog and uses it well to move the stories along and keep the reader engaged and entertained. The glossary at the end is as absorbing as it is informative. Bouquet is a delightful book. The large type and short stories of various lengths make it perfect for traveling, waiting for the school bus, or reading on vacation.
