The next conjunction of the same planets after the same interval of 19y .85885, will be when they are nearly in the direction of C, Saturn having moved through a few degrees more than another two thirds of his orbit. The third conjunction, after the same interval of time, will occur when these planets have come around once more nearly to the direction of A from the sun. Thus...
