

In 1867 the consumption of alcoholic beverages consisted of 30,875,000 gallons of British and foreign spirit?, equal, at 20s. per gallon, to 30,875,000; of 890,000,000 gallons beer, which, at ls. 6d. per gallon, gives 67,000,000; and of 13,583,000 gallons wine, which, taking the declared value plus the duty, and adding 20 per cent, for distribution, gives 6,860,000, making a total of 104,735,000. In 1883 the consumption was 36,639,000 gallons British and foreign spirits, equal to 36,639,000; 966,000,000 gallons beer, worth 72,000,000; and 14,195,000 gallons wine, worth 7,366,000, making a total of 116,005,000, showing an increase of 10 47 per cent. In 1867 the consumption of non-alcoholic beverages consisted of 97,000,000 lbs. tea, valued at 12,314,000; 40,000,000 lbs. coffee, valued at 2,011,000; and 7,500,000 lbs. cocoa, valued at 461,000, making a total of 14,586,000. In 1883 the consumption was 279,529,000 lbs. tea, valued at 16,106,000; 45,376,000 lbs. coffee, valued at 2,009,000; and 14,478,000 lbs. cocoa, valued at 573,000, giving a total of 18,688,000, showing an increase of 28 12 per cent. But if we take the consumption and cost of these articles at the two periods per head of the population, we find, as regards alcoholic beverages, that in quantities there was an increase of 8-17 in the consumption of spirits, but a decrease of 8-63 per cent, in the consumption of beer, and of 11 11 per cent, in the consumption of wine; whereas in the case of non-alcoholic beverages, there was an increase...
